
# New Executive






Rock n Road Cycling Club Vice-President Larry has been busy grooming the fatbike trails at the Little Red River Park and they are GTG!




## Structured Road Training Ride


The ITT Series is back in 2026!



##### **Sunday, May 25th in Christopher Lake**
